OUR SCHOOL

The Canadian Section is a grade 1 – 8 school. In 2023-24, there were 70 students and 7 Canadian teachers. Class size ranges from 9 to 18 students with 6 multi-grade classes. Here is the configuration of this year's classes:

English Program

- 1 – 2 – 3
- 4 – 5
- 6 – 7 – 8

French Program

- 1 – 2
- 3 – 4 – 5
- 6 – 7 – 8

In the past, classes have been combined for subjects. For example, English and French class students are combined during Physical Education, Health, and the Arts. Please note, there are no special education supports in our school beyond what would be provided by the teacher in a regular classroom.

OUR PROGRAMS

Our school follows the Ontario curriculum with programs in French and English. Curriculum documents are found on the Ministry of Education website: www.edu.gov.on.ca. Subject areas include:

- Language Arts
- Social Studies (Gr. 1-6)
- Mathematics
- Physical Education / Health
- The Arts (Music, Drama, Dance and Visual arts)
- Second language
- Science
- History (Gr. 7-8)
- Geography (Gr. 7-8)

Students are placed in French or English programs. English students take 200 minutes of French each week and French students take 200 minutes of English each week.

ADMISSION

Children of Canadian military members have priority placement in our school. International applications are reviewed in mid-May once our class lists for the following year are established. Admission of international students is based on the following criteria:

- space availability in the grade/class
 - strong academic and language profile
- Please note that your child may be invited for an interview to assess their language and academic level.

Students are placed in grades based on birth year. The table below indicates the age a child must turn by December 31 in order to enter a given grade:

Canadian Section Tuition Fees

Canadian fees are charged by semester (Semester 1: August – December and Semester 2: January – June). Fees vary according to Euro exchange rates. The approximate total cost for the school year is €15,285.00. You will receive a separate invoice from SIS for international fees.

- (a) Exchange rate on August 15 (or the next business day) for Semester 1.
- (b) Exchange rate on January 2 (or the next business day) for Semester 2.
